

FIRST GRADE EXPERIENCE TOUR PRE-FIELD TRIP ACTIVITIES

Objective 1.01 Family Roles

Draw a picture of each member of your family doing something for the family (examples: cooking, cleaning, caring for a pet, going to work, taking care of the children, doing chores). When you get to Old Salem, you will learn about families and the work each member did a long time ago. Then you can compare families of long ago with your own family.

Objective 1.02 Groups

Name some groups to which you and other members of your family belong (examples: church, Scouts, sports teams). Think about this, too: who helps you if you are sick? who responds to a fire? where do you go to purchase groceries? where do you go as a student? At Old Salem, you will find out what groups families and family members belonged to long ago.

Objectives 3.01, 3.03, 6.07 Change in production and consumption of goods and services

Pretend you tried on your warm mittens at the beginning of cold winter weather and found out that they were too small. Describe what you could do to get a new pair of mittens (whom would you tell, where would you go, how long would it take, etc.) When you hear the story "Maria's New Mittens" at Old Salem, you will learn how a child of long ago would get new mittens to replace old ones that were too small.
