

## SECOND GRADE EXPERIENCE TOUR POST-FIELD TRIP ACTIVITIES

### Objectives 2.03, 3.04 Roles performed among individuals, families, and communities

Imagine a mother, father, or young sister or young brother in Salem, and make a list of their responsibilities in the family and in the community.

Make a list of your responsibilities in your family and in your community including responsibilities in school.

### Objective 2.04 Rules and laws

After having visited Old Salem, do any of the classroom rules for the Moravian brothers and sisters sound similar to your classroom rules? Make a list of those rules that are similar.

### Objective 5.05 Maps

On the map of Old Salem, color the buildings and spaces which you saw on your visit.

Break into small groups and draw a picture of the way people traveled to Salem from other areas. Share with the class.

### Objectives 5.06 Describe the people

On your visit to Old Salem, you learned about the potter, the joiner, and the baker. Break into three groups - one group write a description of the potter and draw an illustration of the potter. Group two write a description of the joiner and draw an illustration of the joiner. Group three write a description of the baker and draw an illustration of the baker. Share your work with the class.

### Objective 6.01 Natural resources

Now that you have been to Old Salem, make a class list of the natural resources Moravians used. Be sure to include the potter, the joiner, and the baker. Think about what we use these natural resources for today.
