

## THIRD GRADE EXPERIENCE TOUR POST-FIELD TRIP ACTIVITIES

### Objective 2.02 Similarities and differences among families in different times and in different places

After having visited Old Salem, have a class discussion about how your chores and responsibilities differ from the Moravian brothers' and sisters' chores. Are there any similarities? Break into groups and make a chart of similarities and differences of responsibilities.

### Objective 2.03 Roles performed among individuals, families, and communities

What did you observe at Old Salem as the important businesses or jobs? Revisit your class prediction. Were there many similarities or differences?

### Objective 3.02 Compare and contrast family structure and the roles of its members over time

As a class, see if you can re-create the story of "The Shirt That Grew In the Field" on the activity sheet. Number the pictures in the correct order to show how Christian got his shirt.

### Objective 4.02 Map

On the map of Old Salem, color the buildings and spaces which you saw on your visit.

Break into small groups and draw a picture of the way people traveled to Salem from other areas. Share with the class.

### Objectives 5.03, 5.04 Economic resources within the community

As a class, discuss the different kinds of jobs you learned about at Old Salem. Re-visit and discuss the job of the potter. Think about your experience making a roof tile. Discuss the preparation of the building material (clay) and the actual construction of the roof.
