Objective 1.03 Maps, globes, and artifacts

Find on a globe or on appropriate maps the following places mentioned in the Anna Paulina Shober Hermann story you heard at Old Salem: Salem, North Carolina (now Winston-Salem); Bohemia and Moravia (now part of Czech Republic); Herrnhut, Berthelsdorf, and Niesky, Germany; the Wachau region of Austria; Bethlehem, Nazareth, Philadelphia, and Lancaster, PA; Liverpool, Fairfield, Fulneck, and London, England; Rotterdam, Zeist, and Neuwied, Netherlands; Graceham, Maryland; Newport, Rhode Island; British West Indies; Switzerland; Stone County, Missouri.

Think of one artifact used in the Anna Paulina Shober Hermann story. Write a paragraph describing the object and what it reveals about Anna and her life.

Objectives 4.01, 7.01, 7.02, 13.01 Impact of immigration/North Carolina-Europe connection
